PEs trade their virtual products and services with other PEs nationally and around the world, using virtual money. Trainees - as "employees" in their PEs - earn virtual salaries which they can then spend in the worldwide virtual economy that is managed by EUROPEN-PEN International.

What is EUROPEN-PEN International?
